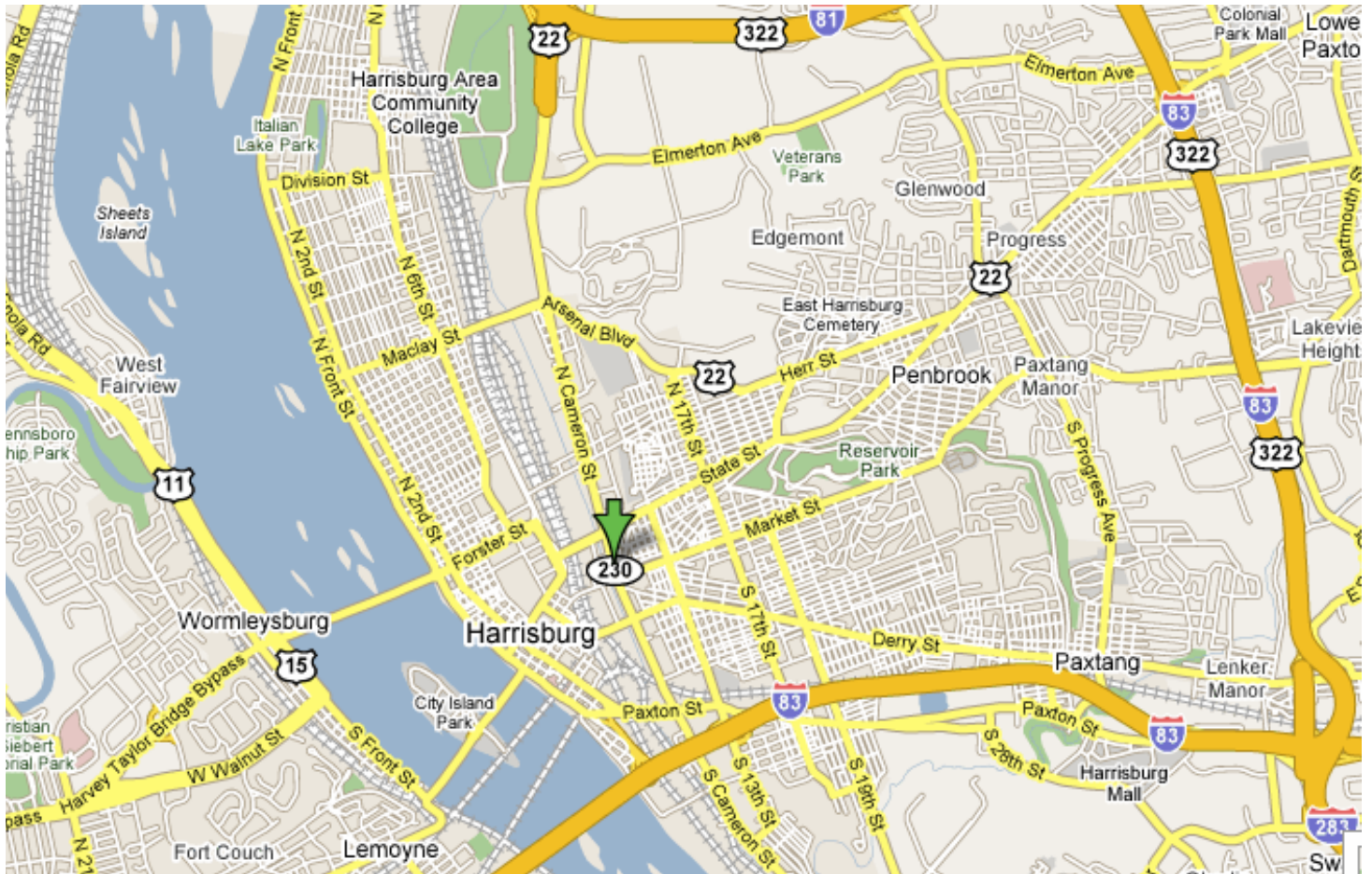

Research Promotion Committee Announcement

The *Research Promotion Campaign* annually raises funds to support ASHRAE's research program. It is conducted by the Society's membership through local chapter volunteers and receives over 7,000 contributions each year from the membership and companies associated with the HVAC&R industry.

This annual support totals more than \$1.5 million annually and is matched dollar-for-dollar by ASHRAE from the proceeds of the annual winter AHR Exposition. Since ASHRAE pays all the fund raising expenses, **100% of every donor's invested dollar goes into the research program.**

This year, the Central PA Chapter has a **meeting sponsorship program**. Firms may sponsor a meeting for \$550. Your company will receive a program card for your employees to use, a copy of the next edition of the manufacturer's directory, recognition in the Pennant, and a \$250 corporate contribution to ASHRAE research.
